



Bocelli Tenor Red IGT Toscana

In the rolling countryside near Pisa stands a wondrous outdoor amphitheater known as *Teatro del Silenzio* (“theater of silence”). For 364 days per year, there is pristine silence, with only the sounds of nature. But one spectacular day every summer, that silence is broken with a concert by tenor Andrea Bocelli. With friends from around the world, he leads a celebration of life and the coming harvest. Tenor Red is the Bocelli family’s homage to this spirit: a Super Tuscan blend of Cabernet, Merlot, and Sangiovese, with aromas of bright cherry, cassis, sage and cocoa.

5.1 grams per liter.

6,000 cases.

13.5% by volume.
