



Krauthaker Pinot Grigio

From Croatian winemaking guru Vlado Krauthaker, we are in love with this Pinot Grigio (and that is a rarity!). Vlado grows 38 different grape varieties on his estate in the Kutjevo region on a Slavonian hill partially within Papuk Nature Park. With southward facing vineyards that are protected from northern winds, he has ideal conditions for environmentally friendly wine-growing. The site location is 45.3° N. latitude, connecting significant winegrowing areas: Kutjevo, Istria, Piedmont, Val du Rhone, Bordeaux and Oregon. Crisp, bright, with an intense gravel complexion make this a serious quaff.
